

**Directions to:  
Sun House, Powdermill Wood, Powdermill Lane,  
Battle, East Sussex  
TN33 0SU**

**By Road:**

From London, Turn off M25 south onto A21 (direction Hastings). At John's Cross roundabout, just south of Robertsbridge, take second exit toward Battle (A2100). As you enter Battle veer left and travel through the town, down the high street, past Battle Abbey on the right. Continue on A2100 as you leave the town, keeping Abbey wall close to your right. About a hundred yards beyond the Abbey, turn Right into Powdermill Lane. Continue past Powdermill Hotel on the right, until the road levels out again. You pass a large house on your left, set back from the road, with big gates. The entrance to Powdermill Wood is just after that, on the right.

From the west (Brighton, Lewes).

Powdermill Lane can be approached from:

- \* the north from the A271 (via Herstmenueux). Cross over roundabout as you enter the north of Battle and continue down high street, past Abbey as above.
- \* the East, from A27- Take A259 after Pevensey Bypass towards Bexhill. Before reaching Little Common turn left onto B2095 (towards Hooe and Ninfield). At Ninfield T- junction turn left (A269) then almost immediately right at mini roundabout onto B2204 towards Catsfield. Once through Catsfield, turn right off B2204, where the road veers to left, into Powdermill Lane, which is signposted. Powdermill Wood is a few hundred yards on the left.

From South (Hastings) From A2100, just past Battle Station on the right, turn left into Powdermill Lane and continue past Powdermill Hotel on the right. Carry on up the hill, until road levels out. Powdermill wood entrance is a little further on , on the right.(see above, paragraph 1.)

**By Train.**

To **Battle** Station. From here you will need a taxi.

**Once in Powdermill Wood;** Drive passed the car park on the right, through the second gateway ahead of you, and veering right, keeping the woodsheds on your left, carry on down the track towards the house, where you can park. There will be signs on the road and at the house to guide you to the Yurt, which is a short walk through the woods.
